PURPOSE

The Martha Adams Chapter of Grambling University National Alumni Association awards a scholarship to college bound high school seniors and current college students based on demonstrated academic achievement and financial need.

CRITERIA

To be eligible for assistance, the student must be a graduating high school senior or a current college student who resides in St. Helena, St. Tammany or Tangipahoa Parish and who intends to enroll in Grambling State University.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. High school seniors must be a graduate of a public or private high school located in St. Helena, St. Tammany, or Tangipahoa Parish. College students must have a permanent home address in one of the above parishes.
- 2. Applicants must have a cumulative Grade Point Average of at least **2.5** to qualify for the award. A transcript must be submitted indicating the **final GPA for high school seniors** or the **current GPA for college** applicants.
- 3. Applicants are required to submit an original 500 word typed essay.
- 4. A signed Scholarship Funds Disbursement Disclaimer must be submitted. A Parent/Guardian signature is required for applicants under 18.

AMOUNT

The scholarship will be in the amount of a one-time award of \$500.00.

DEADLINE

The application deadline is **July 31, 2021**. All applications must be mailed to and deposited in the chapter mailbox or emailed by the deadline. All applications received after the **July 31st** deadline will not be considered. <u>Award notification date: August 13, 2021</u>. Martha Adams Alumni Chapter is not responsible for undelivered applications.

Please submit a typed 500 word essay response to the following question. The format of the essay should be:

- double-spaced,
- 12-point Times New Roman font,
- one-inch margin on all sides, and
- applicant's full name typed in the upper right-hand corner of each page.
- A cover sheet is required.

ESSAY QUESTION

According to the Pew Research analysis of the 2015 American Community Survey Data, at least %15 of U.S. households with school-aged children do not have access to high speed internet and the majority of those households are low income. This has obviously been a challenge for students during COVID-19. What tactics can be employed to help students have affordable access to the internet and other equipment and devices needed to continue their academic work?

The essay is an important part of the selection process. In reviewing the essays, the committee will consider the following criteria in scoring the essays:

- Creativity
- Correct spelling, grammar, and punctuation
- Originality and quality of ideas presented
- Use of research materials to support ideas and assumptions
- Adherence to essay guidelines
